

At the end of every Mass, I remind everyone: "Be safe, be happy, and be holy." These simple words carry a deep message for our daily Christian living. They are not just kind words of farewell, but a spiritual compass that can guide us through our week.

To be safe means to value and protect the gift of life God has given us, to act responsibly, care for our health, and promote peace and respect in our relationships and community. In a world filled with distractions, pressures, and uncertainties, being safe is not only about avoiding harm or accidents; it is also about living responsibly and with awareness of God's presence.

To **be happy** is to live with the joy that comes from knowing God's love. True happiness is not found in possessions or success, but in a heart that is grateful, forgiving, and trusting in the Lord. When we live with joy and gratitude, we become witnesses of Christ's light to others.

To **be holy** is to let God's love transform us each day. Holiness is not perfection, but faithfulness - saying "yes" to God in the ordinary moments of life. So, when I say, "Be safe, be happy, and be holy," it is more than a farewell - it is a gentle reminder of our Christian mission to live with care, joy, and holiness in all that we do.

A Way of Living the Gospel

So, when you leave the church and hear me say, "Be safe, be happy, and be holy," remember that it is more than a farewell - it is a mission.

Be safe - honor the gift of life.

Be happy - live with gratitude and joy.

Be holy - let your life reflect the love of Christ.

If we live these three simple calls, our community will not only be safer and happier, but also a true reflection of the Kingdom of God here on earth.


