



A Message from the Finance Council Chair, Dennis Dionne

We are grateful for the financial support that you have provided to the parish throughout the fiscal year. We have updated the parish each month with financial information through a report and notes in the weekly bulletin and now with a weekly report of collections and budget comparison so that each parishioner who takes a bulletin is informed about the financial situation of the parish. Our annual Stewardship Report looks at the annual total financial situation of the parish.

For the year ending June 30, 2025, our total income increased by 0.50% during the year. One reason for this change was that we changed our on-line giving processor from Faith Direct to Flocknote. The main reason for the change was our contract was due to expire in early March. When the change came, there was a drop off in online giving portion of our income. We are making every effort to bring that portion of our plate income back to previous levels and increase that opportunity for parishioners to sign up.

Our expenses also increased during the year but at a more substantial rate of 21%. Salaries and benefits and Utilities and Maintenance expenses increased by 5.5% and 22% respectively due in part because of insurance benefits increases. Other expenses for Hospitality, Administrative and Chancery Assessments decreased by 22% and 2% respectively. When removing Depreciation expense from the calculations to determine Income or (loss), we realize that Depreciation is a non-cash expense and comes from our Reserve study for maintaining the fixed assets of the parish. For fiscal 2025 we would show a positive net income, but lower than in fiscal 2024 by 15.1%.

We reduced our reserves to minimum levels to pay for capital improvements (listed on the following page) without additional borrowing indebtedness. Any future planned capital projects will require the parish to look at a future Capital Campaign.

We thank you for your generosity to support and maintain our parish.

Capital Improvements

The Prince of Peace Parish Buildings and Properties Committee is pleased with the improvements that were made to the Parish campus between July 1, 2024 and June 30, 2025. These improvements include:

- A new rectory property was purchased to house parish clergy and is currently under mortgage.
- An additional backflow valve was installed to improve the functionality and safety of the parish's fire suppression system in compliance with current safety standards.
- Although the south parking lot project was completed during the current fiscal year, the decision and planning for this renovation were approved in the previous fiscal year. The total cost of the project was \$355,557, which was funded through our Parish Reserve and funds returned to the parish from the Together Campaign.


